Winter Market Opens To A Big Crowd!

The first-ever MFM Winter Market opened on Saturday at **Montgomery Presbyterian Church**, 9994 Zigzag Rd., and the room was full!

THANK YOU for making the first week a success. Vendors were busy and some sold out.

We expect the same this week, so shop early, especially for farm-fresh produce. You will find broccoli, kale, green beans, beets, potatoes, microgreens, local apples and more.

And there might be some tomatoes picked right before the freeze.

You will find **pies**, several varieties of **sourdough bread** and homemade cookies.



And, as always, fresh eggs and pastured meat and chicken.

You will also find some great **artisan foods**, like cranberry-apple butter, hot pepper mustard, squash pizza crusts, jams and jellies, local honey, plus natural pet foods.

We have some **new vendors** at the Winter Market. Garden Of Eaten Fresh Foods, makes pickles, salsa and hummus. Plymouth Springs Fish Co., owned and run by a Montgomery family, brings frozen farmed rainbow trout, smoked trout and smoked trout spread.

Some favorites make their first visit to the Winter Market this Saturday. Cucina Della Patrizia is back with homemade Italian specialties. RLM is bringing one-of-a-kind cutting boards.

The big red school bus means Caveman Crepes will be there for breakfast.

When you check the **list of vendors below**, you will see some of your regular favorites plus crafters who sell at the Winter Market.



Most of the vendors will be there every week, but a few will be there on and off. It's not too early to buy gifts for family and friends, and special treats for your holiday dinners.

The Winter Market will run from **November 4th until December 23rd**. But, we will take off on the Saturday after Thanksgiving.

The Winter Market will accept **SNAP benefits and credit cards**. Come to the Market Manager's booth to find out about both.

The MFM Winter Market is located at 9994 Zigzag Rd., just 5 minutes from Montgomery Elementary.

New hours start 30 minutes later: 9:30am to 12:30pm.

The church is easy to find.

From our current location at Montgomery Elementary School, you head north on Montgomery Rd. to the first traffic light, at Mitchell Farm Ln. Turn left and go straight until the street ends. (The name changes to Zigzag Rd.) Turn right and the church is about two blocks down. Or you can approach from Kenwood Rd. Turn at the stoplight at Zigzag Rd. and follow it a few blocks across the overpass for I-71. You will be facing the church. Or use your GPS or mapping app.
