Winter Market Ready For Thanksgiving!

As you get ready for Thanksgiving, think of how the Montgomery Winter Market can help make your dinner a little different this year!

Many of our vendors are taking holiday orders. Get in touch with them if you want something special for your celebration.

This Saturday, you will find a room full of good food. Here are a few suggestions for the holidays.

Pies and Other Pleasures is bringing fall season pies decorated with turkeys, leaves and apples made from pie crust. A pie bought on Saturday will hold fine in your refrigerator, or you can freeze it and refresh it in the oven on Thursday.

Crackling Crust is bringing a variety of sourdough bread, including baguettes and Cranberry Walnut. Michelle will also have smoked corn bread (for stuffing?), dinner rolls, and apple pie bread pudding for dessert.



Angie Tee is bringing her cranberry sauce, curried butternut squash soup, sweet potato beet soup and a beautiful carrot-kale-cashew rainbow salad.

Believe it or not, Bethel Lane has tomatoes! They were grown in soil, but protected from the cold in a hoop house. Also, greens and crab apple butter.

Jessie's Garden will bring several varieties of microgreens to dress up and spice up your salads and dishes.

You will also find more fresh produce to dip in hummus, salsas, and smoked trout dip, plus cheese and Italian bread sticks to snack on before dinner, cookies for after dinner, and local honey for your tea and coffee.

What about a holiday treat from Argos for your dog and cat?

The Winter Market will run **until December 23rd**. But, we will take off next Saturday after Thanksgiving.

The Winter Market accepts **SNAP benefits and credit cards**. Come to the Market Manager's booth to find out about both.

The MFM Winter Market is located at **Montgomery Presbyterian Church, 9994 Zigzag Rd.**, just 5 minutes from Montgomery Elementary.



New hours start 30 minutes later: 9:30am to 12:30pm.

The church is easy to find.

From our current location at Montgomery Elementary School, you head north on Montgomery Rd. to the first traffic light, at Mitchell Farm Ln. Turn left and go straight until the street ends. (The name changes to ZigZag Rd.) Turn right and the church is about two blocks down. Or you can approach from Kenwood Rd. Turn at the stoplight at Zigzag Rd. and follow it a few blocks across the overpass for I-71. You will be facing the church. Or use your GPS or mapping app.

We are grateful to the Church's lay leadership, Rev. Michelle Bacon, and Winter Market coordinator Dave Dickey for their support and hard work.
