

What's in season for June 25th?

Tomatoes, blueberries, gooseberries, cucumbers, peppers, broccoli, zucchini, squash, cauliflower, carrots, white-skinned potatoes, pickles, onions, kohlrabi, cherry tomatoes, turnips, spinach, kale, romaine, spring mix, radishes, sugar snap peas,

green onions, beets, garlic, peppers, mini bell peppers, baby Bibb, baby Romaine, baby Kale, multiple varieties of living head lettuce, wheatgrass, lettuce mixes, baby mustard mix, herbs, mint, greens, microgreens, popcorn, oyster mushrooms, shiitake mushrooms, lion's mane mushrooms, edible flowers, hanging baskets, cut flowers, lavender and starter veggie, herb and house plants.



Westwind Flower Farm

Amy Phipps Baxter started Westwind Flower Farm in the summer of 2020 right here in Montgomery to bring fresh-cut flowers to our community. Amy employs regenerative and organic techniques to improve the soil and give back to the land, resulting in chemical-free, pollinator-friendly blooms. Preorders for bouquets are available this year for farmers market customers.

For the 2022 season Amy made a few changes to her flower

farm. She began growing cool flowers in the fall for harvest in early spring. The star or the Spring flower offerings are tulips. The 3,500 tulips are grown in raised beds. Varieties are Single Darwin long-stemmed, Multiple Parrots, Fringed, and many Doubles. Other flowers include foxglove, Bachelor Buttons, feverfew, French Carnation, Bellflower, Ammi, Bupleurum, Violas, Sweet William, Anemone, ranunculus, and many others.

Moreover, Amy is offering a summer flower subscription for weekly flowers starting June 30. Love having fresh flowers all summer? Get your fix weekly for 13 weeks! The 15-stem Westwind bouquet is arranged in a glass jar and includes whatever beauties are blooming at the moment. Color and flower choices are determined by the grower. The subscription includes one bouquet for 13 consecutive weeks available for local delivery on Thursdays, porch pickup on Thursdays at Westwind Flower Farm, or Saturday mornings at our Montgomery Farmers' Market.
